



## REGULATIONS 2001

The Nordic Film Days Lübeck are the only German film festival devoted entirely to the cinema of north and north-eastern Europe. The festival is organised by the Hanseatic city of Lübeck in cooperation with the film institutes and foundations of Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden and the corresponding film institutions of the Baltic States. Patrons of the Nordic Film Days Lübeck are the Nordic ambassadors and consuls.

The Nordic Film Days are an independent film festival with an international competition. The festival presents feature films, documentaries, short films and children's and youth films of high quality from Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway and Sweden as well as German films in the Filmforum Schleswig-Holstein, a survey of the latest film production in and around the region.

Films must have been completed in 2000 or 2001. Films which have been shown or received awards at other international film festivals (A-festivals) are eligible to compete. Limitations apply to films shown at national German festivals.

Films are selected by the Artistic Direction in cooperation with the Nordic film institutes and corresponding Baltic associations. Films can also be submitted directly to the festival. Entry forms are available through the office of the Nordic Film Days. Submission deadline is August 17, 2001.
